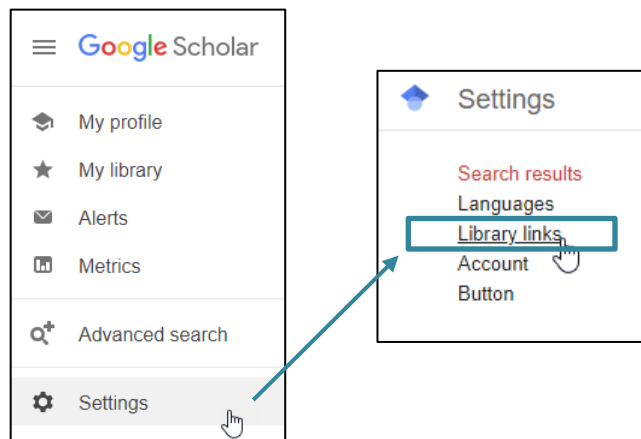




## Connecting Google Scholar to Health Sciences Library Licensed Resources

The step-by-step instructions below will help power your Google Scholar results with content from the Health Sciences Library’s licensed holdings when available.

1. Go to [scholar.google.com](https://scholar.google.com) and log in to your Google account.
2. Go to Settings (located under three lines in the upper left-hand corner), then select “Library links”



3. From the “Library links” page search for **Loyola University – Full-Text @ Loyola**. Check the box to the left then hit save.
